ESF SUPPORT

administrative capacity building (ACB) including **better regulation** is one of the ESF priorities for the 2007-2013 period (Article 3.2(b) – Regulation EC 1081/2006) of the Convergence objective
ACB actions represents 2.7% of all ESF funds – around 2 bil. EUR (500 mil. in Poland)

WHY IS IT IMPORTANT FOR ESF?

Effectiveness of public service is the precondition for efficient planning and policies realisation promoting social – economic development, contributes to economic growth and rise in the employment rate;

regulatory quality improvement one of the main factors of socio-economic progress (NRP)

WHY IS IT IMPORTANT FOR ESF?

Traditional aims of ESF - the higher employment rate, increase in the number of better quality workplaces and facilitating social inclusion cannot be achieved without the support for effective administration (including **better regulation** programmes).

HC OP TARGETS

3 (out of 16) targets of Priority V HC OP *good governance* refer to better regulation:

- Simplification of national legal acts
- Optimization of the system for RIA
- Implementation of the system for measuring administrative costs

ESF PROJECTS SUPPORTING REGULATION REFORM PROGRAMME

- 10 mln PLN project submitted by the Ministry of Economy – *Reform of the legislative process and simplification of existing law*
- project by MoE, *open consultation of legal documents online (pilot project)*, 2 mln PLN
- **Any new projects?** (mid-term review)
