

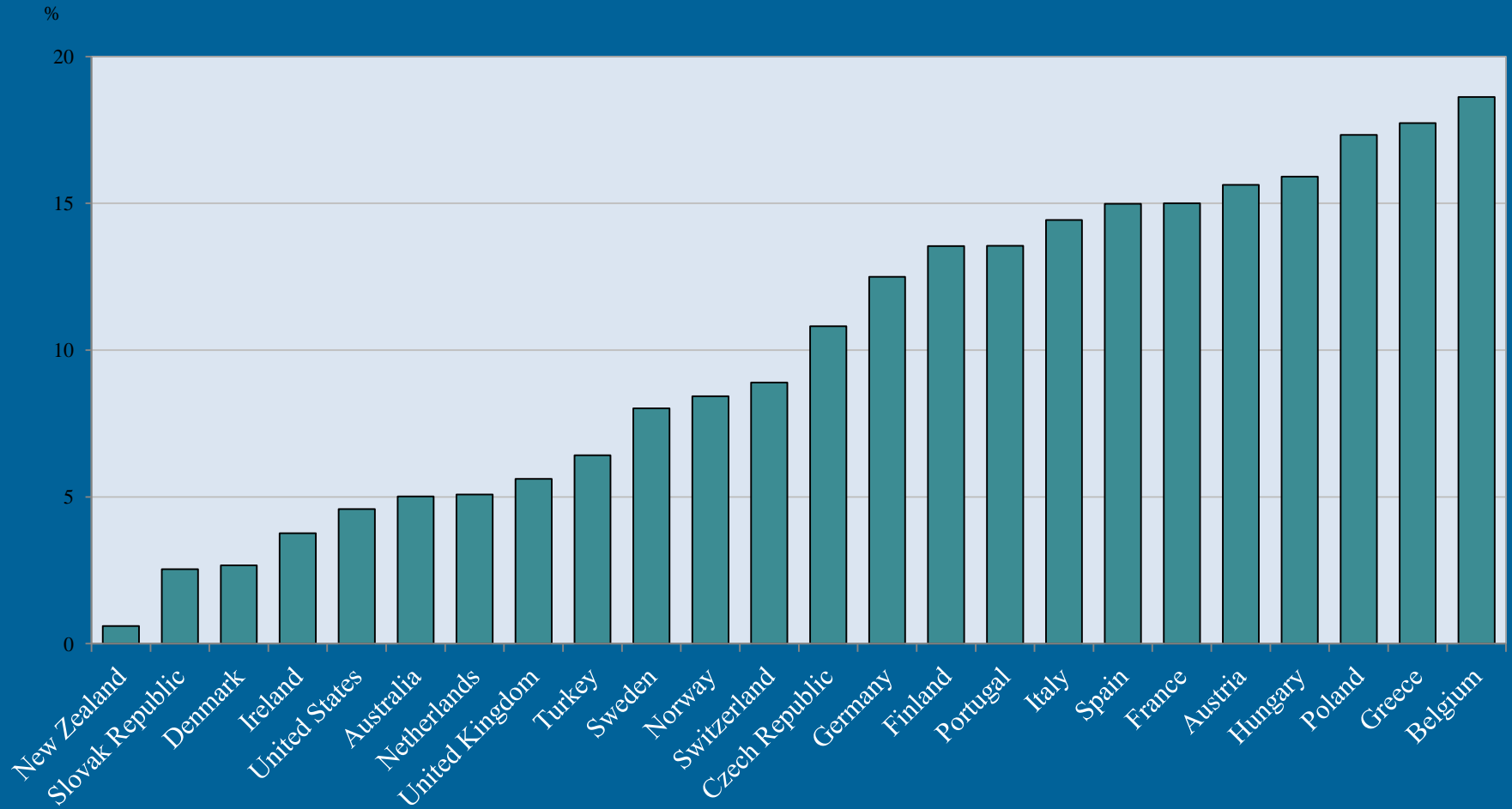

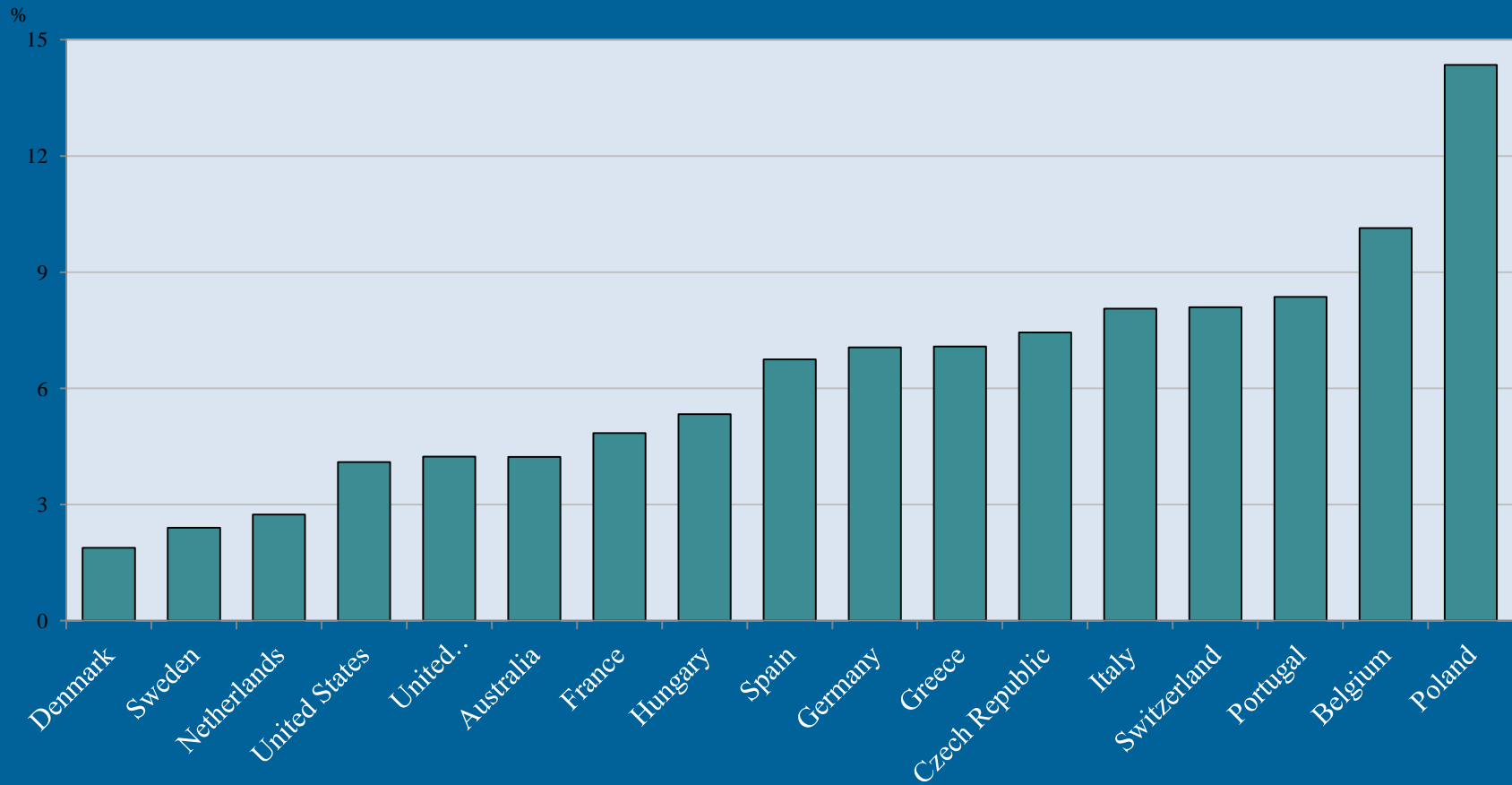

# Policy recommendations (1)

- *Re-launch the programme on administrative simplification using results of the baseline measurement...*
  - Second stage of the programme takes account of the measurement, delays in simplification proposals
- *...setting new, realistic targets for individual ministries and a timeline...*
  - N/A, engagement of other ministries still not clear
- *...creating efficient co-ordination structures and reporting mechanisms...*
  - Co-ordination strengthened by creating the function of the Government plenipotentiary for reducing bureaucracy – effects yet to be shown

# Policy recommendations (2)

- *...and improving stakeholders' involvement.*
  - N/A, no institutional structures created
- *Develop a comprehensive, whole-of-government administrative simplification strategy, better interconnect e-government with administrative simplification.*
  - The regulatory reform programme is being reformulated, better co-ordination with e-government is clearly visible
- *Develop a communication strategy with stakeholders and general public.*
  - N/A

# Policy recommendations (3)

- *Consider broadening and widening of the simplification programme.*
  - The programme takes into account irritation costs, focuses more on citizens
- *Establish systematic evaluation of administrative simplification.*
  - Still not a firm part of RIA
- *Strengthen the RIA system.*
  - The RIA system is being audited and reformed
- *Improve consultations throughout the whole process of making legislation.*
  - Consultations are being strengthened with the reform of RIA, consultation portal, stakeholders still complaining

# Conclusions

- Poland is on the right track to implement OECD recommendations and to improve its regulatory policy.
- A lot remains to be done – especially adopting a whole-of-government approach including co-ordination structures.
