Description of the measure	<p>Uncooked pig meat may only be imported from Canada and New Zealand. Denmark has been able to send de-boned pig meat for heat treatment in Australia before release. The heat treatment requirement was introduced to reduce the risk from PRRS</p> <p>The Import Risk Assessment (IRA) published by Australia in 2004 permits heat treatment of de-boned meat also to be carried out in the country of origin.</p> <p>A market for cooked bone-in hams has been identified. However, this has been excluded by the 2004 IRA because of newly identified concerns over PMWS. Furthermore, the presence of PRRS and/or PMWS in a country precludes exports of fresh/frozen pig meat of unrestricted release, except on the basis of regionalisation.</p> <p>The IRA also permits imports of dried cured hams of the Serrano and Parma type. Draft conditions for import are currently under discussion with Spain and Italy respectively, but the generic conditions might also be the basis for exports of other similar products.</p> <p>The IRA could be the basis of exports from other EU Member States under similar conditions to those applied to Denmark, and would permit trade in fresh/frozen meat from Member States or zones of Member States which are free from PRRS and PMWS. However, criteria for recognition of freedom have not been specified and are under discussion between the Commission and Australia.</p>
Barrier Status	Ongoing
	<p>The EU considers that the import conditions for PMWS and PRRS derived from the Import Risk Assessment are disproportionate and unjustified, and that the Level of Protection required by Australia can be achieved by alternative means, in particular by focussing on zones or countries where the disease is absent or has a lower incidence.</p> <p>An joint EU/Australia expert working group has been set up to examine these options. 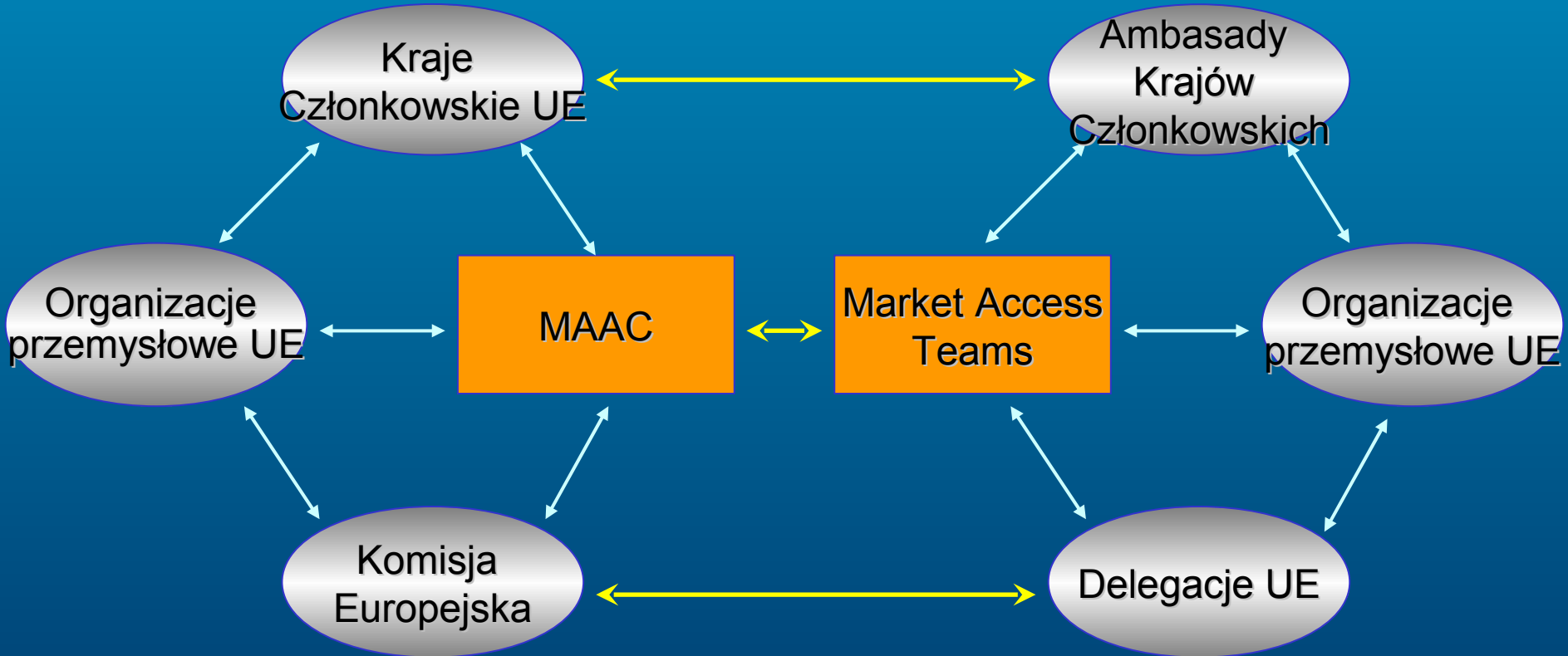
